I, E. Inman  
Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING:

Whereas, B. D. Henson and Annie May Fisher

on or about the 31st day of January in the year of  
our Lord nineteen hundred and thirty-four exhibited their petition in the  
Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Lyla Pearl Henson (Towler), Nettie Bell  
Henson, W. J. Fisher and Helen J. Fisher

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 12th  
day of Feb. 1934, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was  
adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. Inman  
Master in and for the County aforesaid, to Annie May Fisher  
for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgment Roll No. E-1503)

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. Inman  
Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree.

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said Annie May Fisher

the following described property, to-wit:

(1) All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situated  
lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South  
Carolina, and being in the town of Greer on Hubert St  
and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:  
Beginning at an iron pin on Hubert St. corner of  
M. D. Littlefield's lot and running thence with said M. D.  
Littlefield's line 175 ft. to Boyce DeYoung's lot; thence with  
the said Boyce DeYoung's back line 54.4 to an iron pin  
on the said Boyce DeYoung's back line; thence in a  
southerly direction to iron pin on Hubert St 175 feet;  
thence with Hubert St 54.4 to the beginning corner  
and being the same property conveyed to W. J. Henson  
By B. F. Forest by deed, dated October 5, 1917, recorded in  
the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 46 at  
page 485.

Also: (2) An undivided one-half interest in and to  
all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situated  
lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of  
South Carolina, near the town of Greer, containing  
5 1/2 acres, more or less, said tract lying south of the  
Greenville Spartanburg and Anderson Railway, and having  
the following lines, courses, and distances to-wit: Begin-  
ning at a stone on corner of Robison; thence with  
Robison's line N 66° 24' 234.5 to iron pin; thence N 19° 31' 4  
74.7 1/2 ft. to right-of-way of Greenville, Spartanburg and  
Anderson Railway Co.; thence along said right-of-way S 3° 31'  
E. 385 ft. to iron pin, corner of lots of Ballinger; thence with  
Ballinger line S. 28° 24' 818 ft. to the beginning point  
Being the same tract of land conveyed to W. J. Henson  
By W. M. Hawkins by deed dated Sept. 18, 1915, recorded in the  
R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 38 at  
page 11.
