in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said N. A. Hack, his heirs and assigns

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

Known as lot No. 2, Corner Annex as shown on plat recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book F. at page 156, and having approximately the following metes and bounds, to-wit:  
Beginning at a stake on Minus Street, at corner of land now or formerly owned by Minus, and running thence along line of land of said Minus N. 75. 30 21. 145 feet to a stake on a branch; thence down said branch with the meanders thereof as the line to a stake on said branch at northwest corner of lot No. 3 on said plat; thence S. 68-15 E. 148 feet along line of lot No. 3 to a stake on Minus Street; thence along said street N. 33-30 E. 43.5 feet to the beginning corner, and being the same land conveyed to Corine Sanders and Victor Sanders by deed recorded in the R. M. C. Office aforesaid in Deed Book 70 at Page 523.  
This deed conveys all of my right, title and interest in and to said premises acquired by inheritance from Corine Sanders, deceased, and by deed dated November 9, 1931, executed to me by Mary McLoay, J. L. Cunningham, Marie Cunningham and Hattie Mims, and in any other manner acquired.
