in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said
Thomas C. Hender:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate on
the south side of Cleveland Street, in the City of Greenville,
S. C., and described as Lot No. 9, one plat of the property of
Parish, Hender and Martin, which plat is recorded in
the W. H. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat 130 at
L. 1, at page 117, and having, according to said plat the
following dimensions, courses and distances, to wit:
Beginning at an iron post on the south side of
Cleveland Street, which iron post is 37.3 feet west of the
northwest corner of the intersection of Cleveland Street and
W. H. Martin Avenue, also point corner of Lots Nos. 8 and 9,
and running thence along the joint line of said lots N. 30°
34' E. 180 feet to an iron post; thence N. 16° 26' W. 66 feet
to another post near point corner of Lots Nos. 9 and 10;
thence along the joint line of said lots N. 20° 34' E. 180
feet to an iron post on the south side of Cleveland Street;
thence along said Cleveland Street, S. 49° 26' E. 66 feet to the
point of beginning.
