"All my right title and interest in and to that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the eastern side of Houston Street in the 6th Ward of the City of Greenville, and being known and designated as Lot No. 1, abut the adjoining one-half of Lot No. 3, in Block J. of Chapin Spring Land Company property as shown on plat recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book "E", page 41, and having, according to said Plat the following metes and bounds, to wit, Beginning at an iron pin, corner of Houston Street and Lucile Avenue, and running thence with Lucile Avenue N. 88 E. 170 feet to an iron pin, corner Lot No. 4; thence with line of Lot No. 4, S. 2 E. 62.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 88 W. 174.3 feet to an iron pin on Houston Street; thence with Houston Street N. 2 W. 62.6 feet to the beginning corner."
