in the State aforesaid, that he is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said W. G. Lissie

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

being known as lot no 100, Block E, as shown on plat of East Post, part of Boyce Addition, said plat being recorded in the office of Registrar of Public Conveyance in Book A, page 383, and described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin at the corner of Richland Way and Kypsey Avenue, now known as Hayler Street, and running thence with Richland Way 127 feet 10 inches to an iron pin on an alley, thence with the alley N. 13-30 E. 50 feet to an iron pin at corner of lot no 101; thence N. 17-30 W. with line of lot 101 to an iron pin on Kypsey Avenue and thence S. 73-30 W. with Kypsey Avenue to the beginning.
