one-hundredth (59 1/100) acres, more or less, adjoining lands
of The Peltier Mfg. Co., also lands of Walter B. Bennett, et al
on the South, the center of the said surfaced Highway on
the East, lands conveyed to me this day (his interest in the
same) by the said L. H. Bennett, on the North, and the
center of Saluda River on the North and the West, and being
a part of that certain tract of land devised to L. H. Bennett,
