in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said L. Perry Davenport, his heirs and assigns forever, all our undivided right, title and interest of, in and to all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

in the City of Greenville, in Ward Five of the said city on Phett Street, and having the following written and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at a pin on the North side of Phett Street corner of lot now or formerly owned by L. P. Hawkins and running thence with the line of the said Hawkins lot, N. 18-40-26-114 feet to a stake in said Hawkins line, thence S. 71-20-26-64 feet to a stake on line of Pack lot, thence S. 18-40-E-114 feet to a stake on North side of Phett Street; thence with line of said Phett Street, N. 71-20-E-64 feet to the beginning corner, containing 7296 feet, more or less, and being the same lot of land conveyed to the said Amanda Turner by Mary Moon Collier by her deed dated May 7th, 1923, and recorded in Vol. 78 page 595, in R. M. Office for Greenville County.

Also, as part of the consideration herein granted agrees to and does hereby assume and agree to pay Note and mortgage over the said lot of land made to John Park, in the sum of Five Hundred Dollars together with interest thereon, also, all funeral and medical expenses of the said Amanda Turner deceased, approximating the sum of Three Hundred and Seventy Five Dollars.
