All of my undivided one-half interest in and to
all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,
and being known and designated as Lot No. 32 of Wade Cothran property as per Plat of
said property recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book "H",
at page 163. Said lot is more particularly described as follows:
Beginning at an iron pin on the North side of Warner Street 139.2 feet from the
Northwest intersection of Warner Street and McPherson Street, and running thence N.
9-35 E. 165 feet to an iron pin on the boundary of the property of the Donaldson
Estate; thence N. 81-15 W. 65 feet to an iron pin, Joint corner of Lots Nos. 32 and
33; thence S. 9-35 W. 165 feet to an iron pin on Warner Street; thence S. 81-15 E. 65
feet to the beginning corner.
