it is hereby paid at the date of these presents by L. A. Raines, of the town of  
Honea Path, in the State aforesaid,

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said  
L. A. Raines:

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being on the  
northern side of the Highway known as the Dunklin Bridge Road, about twenty-four miles  
from Greenville Court House, in Dunklin Township, in the County of Greenville, in the  
State of South Carolina, containing forty-one and 5/10 (41.5) acres, commencing in the  
center of said Dunklin Bridge Road where said tract corners with the northwest corner  
of Lebanon Church lot and running thence eastwardly along said Highway 957 feet, thence  
turning and running N. 35.30 E. 2772 feet to corner, thence turning and running N. 62.15,  
538 feet to a corner, thence turning and running S. 37 W. 1076 feet to corner, thence  
turning and running S. 54.30 W. 503.6 feet, thence turning and running S. 3 W. 748,4  
feet, thence turning and running N. 62.30 W. 722.7 feet to corner, thence turning and  
running S. 29.30 W. 604 feet to the point of commencement, the said tract being more  
fully shown and delineated as tract No. 1, containing 41.5 acres shown on plat of the  
grantor's W. D. Ridgeway Farm, prepared by A.I. Schisler, Surveyor, dated August 8, 1931,  
and being the portion situate on the northern said Dunklin Bridge Road of the  
tract of land heretofore conveyed to the grantor by S. Inman, Master for Greenville  
County, by deed dated 13 January, 1931, recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville  
County in Volume 140, page 267.
