Victor D. Gifford, his heirs and assigns forever, all that un-
 divided one half part, share or interest, of in and to
 all that piece, parcel of land in Greenville Township, Greenville
 County and State of South Carolina about three and one half
 ($\frac{1}{2}$) miles from the City of Greenville near the Old Fair Grounds
 and Racetrack the following metes and bounds:
 Beginning at a stone 340 m on a settlement road and running
 thence with said road, N. 31 E. 21.15 chs. to stone 3 X 0 m.,
 thence N. 58 $\frac{3}{4}$ W. 18.40 chs. to an iron pine; thence S. $1\frac{1}{2}$ E. 25 chs.
