Edward S. GuthrieAll that piece parcel or lot of land in City of Greenville,  
Greenville County, State of South CarolinaBeginning at a stake on the line of the Stewart lot, on the  
north side of Washington St., thence with said Street S. 65 1/4 E. 68 feet to  
a stake, thence N. 26 3/4 E. 80 feet to a stake in the back line of Hoyt lot,  
thence with said last mentioned lot N. 70 1/2 W. 68 1/2 feet to a stake in the  
intersection of the Hoyt and Stewart line, thence S. 26 1/4 W. 74 feet to the  
beginning, containing 5240 sq. ft. more or less. Being the same lot con-

and mortgage covering the premises above described heretofore  
executed by the grantor herein to the Southern Life & Trust Co. (now  
the Pilot Life Ins. Co) for \$9,000.00 recorded in the R.M.C. Office Vol 110,
