Frank Young:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in the City of Greenville in the County and State aforesaid, having the following metes and bounds: beginning at an iron pin on the south-east corner of Casey street extension and an Alley (running from Green Ave. to Anderson st.) and running thence along said Casey St. extension, in a southerly direction, forty feet to line of lot conveyed by me to Mary Johnson; thence easterly, along her line, seventy-three feet, more or less, to stake in rear, thence in a northerly direction forty feet to a stake on said Alley; thence in a westerly direction, along said Alley, seventy and one half feet, more or less; to the beginning point on said corner. This is a part of the land formerly conveyed to me and D. W. Cochran, Jr. and he subsequently conveyed his interest in same to me, the said E. Godfrey Webster, see deed recorded in R.M.
