Mrs. J. M. Sims, her heirs and assigns, forever, the following described property:

All that certain lot of land situate in the County and State aforesaid on the North side of the road leading from Fountain Inn to Fork Shoals, and having the following mates and bounds, to-wit: Beginning on the North side of said road at the corner of building formerly the bank building of the Fork Shoals Branch of the Peoples Bank of Fountain Inn, and running thence N. 27-15 W. one hundred twenty-five (125) feet to an iron pin; thence N. 62-45 E. Thirty (30) feet to an iron pin, corner of lot of Scott Mercantile Company; thence with line of said Scott Mercantile Company S. 27-15 E. One Hundred Twenty-five (125) feet to an iron pin on North side of said road; thence with said road S. 62-45 W. thirty (30) feet to the beginning corner; bounded on the north and west by lands of Katrine Wig. Co., on the east by land of Scott Mercantile Company and on the south by the said road first above mentioned. Together with brick building, vault and vault door, which stand on the premises.
