(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Mrs Mary C. Martin, her heirs and assigns forever:  
 All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and  
 being in Greenville Township, County and State aforesaid, just  
 beyond the limits of the City of Greenville, on the North side  
 of Mills Avenue, said lot being known and designated as lot  
 #18, on a plat of the subdivision of the estate of G.O.P. Mills, de-  
 ceased, in Block "C", said plat being recorded in the R.M.C.  
 Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "C" at page 284. Said  
 lot is more particularly described as follows: Beginning  
 at a stake on Mills Avenue, corner of lot #19, and running  
 thence S. 45-27 W. 59.4 feet to a stake, corner of lot #17, thence  
 along line of lot #17 180.4 feet to a pin; thence 59.4 to a stake at  
 corner of lot #19; thence S 35-26 E. 180.4 feet to the beginning corner.

This is the same lot that was conveyed to us by Milton P. Smith  
 by deed dated the 1 day of October, 1921, and recorded in  
 the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Volume 73, page 577.

The grantee herein assumes and agrees to pay the balance  
 due on a certain mortgage given by the grantees, to the  
 Penn Mutual Life Ins. Co. Company, in the sum of  
 \$3,750.00, now reduced to \$2,250.00, as appears by an ex-  
 tention agreement dated the 1 day of June, 1932. Said  
 mortgage being recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Green-  
 ville County in Mortgage Book 50, at page 480.
