all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.and being on the South side of Arlington Avenue
(otherwise known as Garlington Street) in Ward Five of
the City of Greenville, and being designated as Lot no.
5 in Block B as shown on Plat of Pendleton Street
Realty Association, recorded in the R. M. B. office for
Greenville County in Plat Book A, page 122 and
page 123, and having the following written and bounded
as follows:Beginning at an iron pin on the South side of
Arlington Avenue 300 feet from the Southwest corner
of Summer Street and Arlington Avenue, thence along
Arlington Avenue, N. 72-85-00 E. 50 feet to an iron pin,
corner of Lot no. 6; thence with line of Lot no. 6, S. 10-15-
W. 197 feet, 8 inches to an iron pin, thence S. 72-85-0-
50 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot no. 4; thence with
line of Lot no. 4, N. 15-15-6. 196 feet, 1 inch to the beginning
