in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said *Mabel H. Balmer*, all my right, title and interest, the same being an undivided one-half interest in and to the following piece of real estate, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in the City of Greenville, Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

On the Northwest corner of West Washington Street, and Academy Street, and having the following metes and bounds according to a plat made by Mrs. A. Hudson on July 22, 1905, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin in the Northwest corner of West Washington and Academy Streets and running thence along the northern side of West Washington Street N. 65° 34' 58.5 feet to an iron pin, thence N. 24° E. 92 feet to a point in the line of a lot now or formerly owned by David Henning; thence with the line of said lot S. 70° E. 59.5 feet to an iron pin in the Western line of Academy Street; thence with Academy Street S. 27° 21.96 feet to the point of beginning.

My undivided one-half interest in said property was conveyed to me in deed executed by Margaret Riley et al to M. L. Chesterrelt and myself dated August 1st 1919, and recorded in the P.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 54, page 98. This conveyance is made subject to mortgage executed by M. L. Chesterrelt and myself to the Piedmont Savings & Trust Company, dated April 15, 1925, in the principal sum of \$16,500.00 and recorded in P.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Mortgage Book 89, Page 1183.
