 by a large black oak and running, thence S. 30 W. 18.60
 chains to a stone 3x, thence S. 60 E. 2.25 chains to a
 stone 3x; thence S. 39 1/4 W. 2.56 chains to a stone 3x;
 thence N. 83 1/2 W. 7.37 chains to a red oak 5x6, thence N. 55 3/4
 W. 3.34 chains to a stone 3x, thence S. 62 W. 15.55 chains to
 a pine 3x3, thence N. 77 1/4 W. 7.10 chains to a stone 3x, thence
 N. 51 1/2 E. 2.38 chains to a stone 3x by a pine 3x, thence N.
 61 1/2 E. 21.10 chains to the beginning, containing ~~35 1/4~~ acres more or
 less, bounded by lands of Col. L. Hunt, Mullardin and others,
 being the same conveyed to Anna P. Nichols by J. J. McSwain by
 deed dated November 30, 1904, recorded in book 214 N, page 296.

Also that other tract of land in township, county and state
 aforesaid, known as the Hector Mabill place, adjoining lands of
 Anna P. Nichols, L. S. Barr, L. M. Hubbard, Mrs. Z. Z. Hunt, Paris
 Mountain Land Company and others containing 35.4 acres, more

 old home place, thence N. 34.6. with Barr's line 17.50 chains to pine

 8.15 to a hickory tree, thence S. 26 1/4 W. 30.75 to stone, thence S. 32
 W. 18.55 to stone, thence S. 57 E. 5.35 to beginning, less however,
 4.75 acres conveyed by Anna P. Nichols to L. M. Hubbard January
 12, 1910, deed recorded in book 6, page 475; described as follows:
 Beginning at stone, corner of Hunt land, running thence S. 26
 W. 05 feet to iron pin at station 11 of located line of Paris Mountain
 Railway; thence with center line of said railway 8.75 feet to iron
 pin at station of said railway 19 x 75; thence N. 32 E. 027 feet
 to iron pin; thence N. 57 W. 5.90 feet to beginning, containing
 4.75 acres, more or less, according to survey by C. E. McCallough
 Jan. 10, 1910. The above tract being the same conveyed by J. J.
 McSwain to Anna P. Nichols by deed dated February 8, 1908,
 recorded in book 214 N, page 340, less the conveyance aforesaid.

As part of the consideration for this conveyance the grantee
 herein assumes and agrees to pay the note of Anna P. Nichols
 to L. M. Bassett for \$3300, dated August 27, 1929, upon which
 is due \$2573.00 as of this date, secured by mortgage recorded
 in book 216 Page 257. The grantee however, agrees to pay interest on the
 said note at the rate of seven per centum and not eight per
 centum as provided in said note, and also it is understood
 and agreed that the payments on said mortgage may be
 made at the rate of forty dollars per month.

It is agreed that taxes for 1931 are to be prorated.
