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It is mutually agreed to that the charges for Sewer connections is to be paid by the party of the first part so long as the title to the said Estate is vested in the party of the first party.

The party of the second part hereby covenants and agrees for the consideration of a right of way granted and conveyed by the party of the firstpart, as above designated for the purpose of laying, operating and maintaining a Sewer Main through the land belonging to the Estate of Mrs. E. A. Wood, deceased, as surveyed and laid off by the city Engineer for the town of Greer, S. C., to lay, operate and maintain a connecting Sewer Line at a point in South Main St. opposite the front yard fence of the residence, occupied by F. J. Henderson and extending down said street to the intersection of the Brushy Creek road, thence down the Brushy Creek road to a point about two hundred feet below an old cattle pit crossing, thence about a 45 degree right turn across the corn patch to the main Sewer Line connection.

The Party of the second part further covenants and agrees that the party of the first part and their assigns shall have the right to make all necessary Sewer connections with the main and connecting Lines on each side of same, for a maximum charge of fifty cents per month, payable monthly.

Party of the second part covenants and agrees to furnish water to all connecting water lines at the same price charged others outside the City Limits, and to make water connections for the party of the first part on condition that the party of the first part are to lay and maintain water lines to their premises at their own expense.

It is mutually agreed that all the covenants and agreements herein contained shall extend to and be binding upon the party of the first part and their assigns as well as upon the party of the second part and their successors in Office.
