

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville, and in Dunklin Township, being known and designated as Tract No. 5, according to a plat made by James P. Willis, D. S., December 22, 1926, and being a part of the property of the Estate of Malinda Chapman, said tract of land having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stone 3x6m at the southeast corner of said Tract No. 5, and running thence N. 12 W. 18.50 ch. to a stone; thence S. 83 W. 24.33 ch. to a stone 3x6m; thence S. 5 W. 16 ch. to a stone; thence N. 83 E. 28 ch. to the point of beginning; said tract of land being bounded (in 1896) on the south by Lot No. 4; on the East by Charles Cason land; on the North by Lot No. 6; and on the West by J. T. Cooley land, and containing 40 1/2 acres, more or less.

King and Mrs. Holiday property; thence N. 84-30 E. 9.40 to a stake in creek; thence along the creek as the line 12.16 chs. to a stake; thence S. 84-25 W. 7.38 ch. along the line of W. D. Workman property to a stone; thence S. 83-6 W. 27.03 ch. along the line of D. V. Chapman property to a stone thence S. continuing along line of D. V. Chapman property, 9-15 W. 6.71 ch. to the beginning.

These are the same tracts of land conveyed to Mrs. Ora Chapman by Sallie Holliday, Ecrx. and D. V. Chapman, Exr. of Estate of Frances Chapman, decd., December 1, 1924, by deed recorded in R. M. C. office in Vol. 86, Page 131.

Also, all that certain piece, and parcel of land, lying, being and situate in Dunklin Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, containing 77 acres, more or less, bounded on the North by lands of Stacy Cooley, East by lands of L. V. King, South by lands of Frances Chapman and James Chapman, and on the West by lands of Annie Chapman. This being the same tract of land conveyed to D. V. Chapman by John T. Cooley, on November 23, 1904, and recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County, in Book "NNN", Page 279."
