about three miles south west of Greenville Court House known as Lot No. 18, of Sec. I according to a plat of Falls Main by W. D. Moore, Engineer, March 1, 1913, recorded in plat book C, page 101; Beginning at a pin on east side of Bradley Street, corner of Lot No. 17; thence N. 64° 30' E. 200 feet to a pin; thence N. 24° W. 63 feet to pin, corner of Lot No. 19, thence with Bradley Street 24° 63 feet to the beginning corner being the said lot, same first to me by C. S. West by Deed dated 8th day of September 1910 and recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County Vol. 71 at page 142.
