

TITLE TO REAL ESTATE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

in consideration of the sum of \$13,000.00 (being release of mortgage debt) Dollars,

to me paid by *Anita Hodges*in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *Anita Hodges*, Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in about one and one-half miles from the Court House and near the Trulley Bridge on continuation of Hampton Avenue and being a part of lot no 23 of Marshall's Addition to the City of Greenville, according to a plat prepared by J. R. Southern, December 9, 1897, and recorded in office of R. M.C. for said County and State in Deed Book "E E E" at page 658, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stake on Monroe Street at corner of Lot no 6 and running thence along said Monroe Street 58 feet to center of original line of said lot no 23; thence N. 40° 26' 354 feet to point not marked; thence S. 45° W. 53 feet to a stake; thence along line of lots 10, 9, 8, 7 and 6, S. 39° E. 368 feet to the beginning corner. This lot being approximately one-half of Lot no 23 heretofore referred to. Being the same lot of land conveyed to the grantor herein by E. J. Gibson by deed dated November 10, 1919, recorded in R. M.C. Office for Greenville County in Vol 48 at page 13.

The mortgage heretofore executed by me to Anita Hodges in the sum of \$13,000 dated May 25, 1925 is to remain open for the protection of the mortgagor, but the mortgagee is released from any personal obligation to the above described land as the same conveyed to me by
