in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mrs. Gene L. Huskey, Greenville, Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

In the City of Greenville, on Ebaugh Avenue, Beginning at a stake at the corner of Ebaugh Avenue and Richland Way and running thence with Richland Way 194, feet to stake, corner of lots Nos. 134, and 127; thence with line of lot No. 127, 175 feet to stake on Ebaugh Avenue; thence with Ebaugh Avenue N. 55 W. 84 feet to beginning, being lot No. 126 as shown on plat of East Park recorded in plat book A, page 383.

Also that lot of land in Township, County and State aforesaid, on the south side of Ebaugh Avenue, being the western half of lot No. 127 as shown on said plat, Beginning at a stake on Ebaugh Avenue 84 feet from the intersection of said Ebaugh Avenue and Richland Way, corner of Lot No. 126, and running thence with line of lot No. 126, 175 feet to stake thence S. 55 E. 25 feet; thence parallel with line of lot No. 126, 175 feet to Ebaugh Avenue; thence with Ebaugh Avenue N. 65 W. 25 feet to beginning corner.
