Lot on the east side of Academy Street, between Washington Street and Mcbee Avenue, and beginning at a point on said Academy Street 100 feet from Mcbee Avenue, and running thence N 25° 45' E. 50 feet, thence S 40° 45' E. 38 1/2 feet, thence S 22° 40' W. 50 feet to a stake; thence N 70° 45' W. 41 feet to the beginning corner, being the same lot conveyed to E. L. Goddard by Martha L. Goddard by deed dated February 11, 1920, recorded in the C. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Volume 57 page 584.
