in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said South Carolina Security Company, a corporation, all that place, place or lot of land, in Burncombe Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and being therein as Lot no 5 of the subdivision of McCallough Heights, a plan of which is recorded in the Register's office for Greenville County in Plat Book "E" at page 95, and bearing according to said plat the following notes and boundaries:

Begins at a point on the south side of Burncombe Road, which point is 150.3 ft. in a N.E.W.L. direction from the southwest corner of the intersection of Burncombe and Franklin Roads, running thence with Burncombe Road N 58-27 W, 78 ft. to a stone pine, thence S 32-30 E, 187 ft. to an iron pin, thence S 58-27 E, 74 ft. to a stone pine, thence N 32-30 E, 187 ft. to another pin, the point of beginning on Burncombe Road.

This deed is an absolute conveyance of title in effect so well as form and is not intended as a mortgage, trust conveyance or security of any kind.

It is understood and agreed that the said Carolina Security Company by accepting this deed does not assume or agree to pay the mortgage executed by M. F. Gooddy to the South Carolina Security Company, dated January 14, 1931, which is recorded in the Register's office for Greenville County, Vol 2, pg. 50, payoff, to hold secured the original sum of Two Thousand (\$2,000.00) Dollars and which mortgage was assigned to the Metropolitan Life Insurance Company, the amount aforesaid and holder thereof, shall take same money bank to hand security, upon which there is now due the sum of

The above described land is the same conveyed to me by I. M. Gooddy on the 15th day of September, 1932, deed recorded in office of Register of Deeds Conveyance for Greenville County, in Book 738, page 328.

TO BEXTE AND TO BOLD, all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said South Carolina Security Company, a corporation, its heirs and assigns forever to have and to hold quietly, freehold, forever, by, holders, executors and administrators to
warrant and forever discharge the said premises unto the said South Carolina Security Company, its
heirs and assigns, against all and every person, whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim, the same, or any part thereof.
