TITLE TO REAL ESTATE

STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA.

Greenville County.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Lacey L. Thompson

Be the State aforesaid.

In consideration of the sum of \$1,000 Dollars, paid by J. B. Patterson, as Trustee for Roy Thornhill and William Thornhill, to me, Lacey L. Thompson, as Trustee for James L. Thompson and William L. Thompson, in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. B. Patterson, as Trustee for Roy Thornhill and William L. Thompson, the land described in the following manner, to wit:

Lot No. 2, Block 8, East Place, as shown on Plat recorded in Plat Book 2, page 59, said lot having a frontage of 50 feet on Second Avenue and a depth of 150 feet.

- This conveyance is made subject to the following trusts:
1. I, trust to hold, manage and control the same and receive the income therefrom, with full power to sell and transfer the same and reinvest the proceeds in such property, as he may deem best, with powers to change investments as often as in his discretion is advisable.
 2. To execute my deeds, satisfactions of mortgages, or other instruments, with power to mortgage the property acquired in the execution of this trust, and the grantee and mortgagee shall not be required to see to the application of the proceeds of sale or mortgage of the trust estate.
 3. I, trust to bear the income derived from the trust estate, after paying all the expenses incurred in providing care for the support and maintenance of Roy Thornhill, Anna L. Thompson and William L. Thompson.

The above described land is a portion of the same conveyed to me by James L. Thompson, on the 12th day of February, 1933, deed recorded in office of Register of Deeds Conveyance for Greenville County, in Book 165, Page 113.

TOGETHER with all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the said J. B. Patterson, as Trustee for Roy Thornhill and William L. Thompson, his executors, heirs and assigns forever.

AND, do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said J. B. Patterson, as Trustee for Roy Thornhill and William L. Thompson, his executors, heirs and assigns, against all and every person, who ever lawfully claiming, or to claim, the same, or any part thereof.
