and elsewhere one part of the Jackson Mills property, bounded
as follows and being designated on said plat as Lot
No. 16; said lot has a frontage on Piedmont Avenue of 60
feet and a depth of 100 feet to the property of Jackson Mills.

As part of the consideration for this conveyance the
grantor herein and executors and agree to pay the mortgage
of the grantee to the American Building and Loan Association
for \$130.00, dated April 1st 1882, recorded in book 213, page
270, and also a mortgage of the grantor to C. H. Henderson for
\$150.00, dated January 1st 1880, recorded in book 252, page
