

## TITLE TO REAL ESTATE

in Block One, City of Greenville, being known and designated as part of lot no 16 of Mikens Eagle property as shown on plat of said property, which  
plat is recorded in the Office of the R.W.C. for Greenville County in Plat  
Book First page 251 and Survey made, being described as follows:

Beginning at a corner, going on the south side of East Prentiss Ave. from  
corner of Lot no 16 and 17, running thence N. 38° 50' E. 155.5 feet to an corner  
on the east line of lot no 4, thence along the rear line of lot no 4 S. 59° 02'  
E. 52 feet to a point, which point is approximately five (5') feet from the  
level of Lot no 10; thence S. 34° 55' W. 162 feet, more or less, to a point on  
the north side of East Prentiss Ave., thence with East Prentiss Ave  
W. 52.08 ft. to the corner of beginning, being all of lot no 16  
except a strip of land width of six inches to be reserved adjoining lot no 10.
