near McRae's Mill, and being known and designated as lots Nos. 19 and 20 in Block V, in a sub-division of land known as Riverside, a plat of which is on record in Plat Book A, page 323 R. M. C. Records of Greenville County, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at the corner of Colonial Avenue and Green Street, and running thence with the line of Green Street, N. 10-15 E. 125 feet to a stake on an alley; thence along the line of said alley N. 79-45 W. 100 feet to a stake on the corner of lot 18; thence with the line of that lot S. 10-15 W. 125 feet to a stake on Colonial Avenue; thence along the line of Colonial Avenue, S. 79-45 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner.
