

TITLE TO REAL ESTATE

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Matilda Johnson all that piece, parcel or bit of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

in the City of Greenville on the East side of Pettigree Street and bounded above and designated as lot no. 203 shown by plat of S. D. Hester dated November 1st, 1921 of a sub-division of the property of H. H. Guffin which lot is more particularly described as follows: To wit: Beginning at a stake on the east side of Pettigree Street corner in a northerly direction from the north side of Whitsett Street on the corner of lot not used running thence with Pettigree Street N 16.60 feet to a stake, thence S 89.50 E. 60.7 feet to a stake; thence S 0-21-21 47 feet to the line of Lot 201; thence along line of said lot N 52-37-4 77.7 feet to the beginning corner.
