Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate lying and being in the state and county aforesaid in Chicks Springs Township, Beginning at an iron pin in the center of the Road leading from Worleys store on the Camp road to the Paris Mountain Road at the Holiness Church, and running thence S. 74. 0W-954, $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to an iron pin just across the branch, thence down said branch 400 feet to an iron pin on the right of way of the P. & N. R. R.; thence along the right of way of the said P. & N. R. R. in an easterly direction to an iron pin on Sallus Russells Line, thence N. 35.-40, E. 864.5 feet to an iron pin in center of road named above, thence along the center of said road N. 42-30 W. 283 feet to the beginning corner, and containing 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres, more or less, and being a portion of the same land conveyed to me by E. Inman, Master by deed bearing date Jan. 4, 1833 and recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Book J, page 180. Note iron pins called for as being in center of road named herein are driven 14 feet on the S-W side of the road so as to preserve them.
