TITLE TO REAL ESTATE

all that place, place or places herein

"All that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situate lying and being in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit: On the Easley Bridge Road, known as Lot No. 52 of property of Estate of J. Rowley Town made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book _____ page ____, and having the following rates and bounds, to-wit:
