in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Wade T. Rainey,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chicks Springs, Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing 61.90 acres, known as the T. J. Rainey place, located on Paris Mountain

Public Road, six miles north of Greenville, on waters of Mountain Creek, bounded on the north by lands of J. E. Batson, on the east by lands of Waddell; on the South by lands of Wm. F. Roberts, on the West by lands of City of Greenville, having the following courses and distances according to survey and plat made by W. A. Hester, plat dated September 23, 1932;

Beginning on stone OM on Buckhorn Road; thence S. 12 degrees E. 2.00 chains to bend; thence S. 5 degrees E. 2.37 chains to bend; thence S. 40 degrees E. 2.19 chains to bend; thence S. 16 degrees E. 6.10 chains to bend; thence S. 4 1/2 degrees E. 2.50 chains to bend; thence S. 25 1/2 degrees E. 1.70 chains to bend; thence S. 6 1/2 degrees E. 1.36 chains to bend; thence S. 25 1/2 degrees W. 4.40 chains to R. O.; thence S. 11 degrees E. 14.50 chains to stone OM; thence N. 31 1/2 degrees E. 23.13 chains to stone; thence North 1.25 chains to stone; thence S. 84 degrees E. 5.40 chains to p. o. OM; thence N. 20 1/2 degrees E. 6.50 chains to stone; thence N. 38 degrees W. 19.00 chains to stone; thence N. 37 degrees W. 19.10 chains to stone; thence S. 13 degrees E. 12.65 chains to the beginning corner.
