all that place, premises,

All of that plat or lot of land being in Greenville County and Austin Township and State aforesaid, and having the following mates and bounds:

Beginning at a stone in Fowler's Branch E. G. Whitmire's corner and running thence down said branch S. 37 W. 4.50 to Bend; thence S. 32 W. 4.40 to Bend in Branch thence S. 23 W. 3.68 to Bend; thence S. 16 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 3.50 to the center of Gilder Creek, thence down said Creek S. 23 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 5.82 to Bend; thence S. 43 E. 7.25 to the center of a long ditch, thence up said ditch N. 30 E. 1.75 chains to Bend, N. 1 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 1.83 to Bend; thence N. 4 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 16.23 to an iron pin above head of ditch; thence N. 28 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 5.54 to a stone on E.
