

TITLE TO REAL ESTATE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, THAT I, Louisa C. Fossett,

and assumption of mortgage hereinafter set forth, and transfer of lot in
Spartanburg County valued at \$3500.00,
paid by Millie McGarity and Patrick McGarity.

In the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and
lend unto the said Millie McGarity and Patrick McGarity,
all that gives, passes or lies of land in Gantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,
on the West side of the Augusta Road, about three and one-half miles from the City of
Greenville, on Federal Highway No. 28.

Beginning at a point in the center of said highway and running thence with
said highway S. 1-0 E. 200 feet; thence S. 89-0 W. 730 feet to the old Augusta Road;
thence with the center of the old Augusta Road N. 36-40 E. 263.3 feet to pin; thence N.
89-0 E. 573 feet to the point of beginning, containing 3 acres, more or less, and being
Tract No. 3 according to Plat of record in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat
Book H, at page 188, and being the same conveyed to me by Ida C. Gaines by her deed dated
October 19th, 1933, and recorded in Deed Book 115, page 563, R. M. C. Office for Green-
ville County.
