TITLE TO REAL ESTATE

located on the road to Simpsonville, $\frac{3}{4}$ miles from Greenville, S. C., containing 46.62 acres more or less, having the following notes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the road to Simpsonville, running thence S. 34 E. 12.00 to stone; thence N. $75\frac{1}{2}$ E. 11.60 to stone; thence N. $19\frac{1}{2}$ W. 32.87 chains crossing public road and branch, to stone at J. R. Riddle corner; thence S. 73 W. 8.02 to stone; thence S. $15\frac{1}{2}$ W. 22.24 to stone on Simpsonville road; thence road the line S. 68 E. 2.13 to bend in road; thence road still the line N. $84\frac{1}{2}$ E. 4.63 to iron pin, beginning corner.
