TITLE TO REAL ESTATE

STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, S. L. Blakely, widow,

in the State aforesaid,

In consideration of the sum of One thousand and no/10 (\$1000.00)

Dollars,

to me paid by Minnie West

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Minnie West,

all that gives, passes or has of land in Paris Mountain, Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing 42.25 acres, more or less, known as the old Shockley Home place, located on the Funt Bridge public road, 8 miles from Greenville, bounded by lands of Gibson, Bob Williams, Sullivan, Stearns, and having the following lines and bounds according to survey and plat by W. J. Riddle, March 1920;

Beginning at an iron pin in road line, running thence with the road N. 65 degrees 45 minutes W. 3.03 chains to pine tree; thence S. 18 degrees 18 minutes W. 0.76 chains to stone; thence S. 80 degrees W. 9.14 chains to stone; thence N. 88 degrees W. 3.50 chains to stone; thence S. 17 degrees 30 minutes W. 7.09 chains to white oak stump; thence S. 29 degrees 30 minutes W. 11.00 chains to White Oak; thence S. 41 degrees 45 minutes E. 15.35 chains to stone, Dog Wood gone; thence N. 66 degrees 15 minutes E. 5.63 chains to fork of branches 3x; thence branch the line N. 37 degrees E. 7.43 chains to bend; thence N. 30 degrees 40 minutes E. 3.98 chains to fork of branches 3x; thence N. 18 degrees 30 minutes W. 7.68 chains to Hickory stump; thence N. 2 degrees 30 minutes W. 9.73 chains to stone; thence N. 17 degrees 45 minutes E. 3.50 chains to " in road; beginning corner.

Grantee assumes and agrees to pay taxes for the year 1934.

The above described land is the same conveyed to me by Sarah Elizabeth Farr, on the 21st day of April 1920, deed recorded in office of Register of Deeds Conveyance for Greenville County, in Book 69 Page 142.

AND I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Minnie West, her heirs and assigns, against myself and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim, the same, or any part thereof.
