All that certain place, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the  
 county and State aforesaid, in Greenville Township on Holliday Avenue near Parker  
 High School Building and known as Lot #13 of the A. W. Holliday property on plat  
 recorded in Plat Book "P", at page 167; said lot having a frontage of 57 feet on  
 Holliday Avenue, with a depth in parallel lines of 120 feet adjoining Lots #12, #14
