on Aberdeen Avenue, and being known and designated as Lot No. 5, Plat 3, of the Mary B. Lewis Property, said Plat being recorded in Plat Book H, page 79, R. M. C. office for Greenville County, and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on Aberdeen Avenue, joint corner of lots Nos. 4 and 5, and running thence with joint line of said lots S. 63-12 E., 200 feet; thence S. 21-05 E., 45 feet; thence with joint lines of lots Nos. 5 and 6, S. 65-08 W., 223 feet to a point on Aberdeen Avenue; thence with said Avenue N. 4-55 E., 85 feet to the point of beginning, being the same lot conveyed to me by Mary B.
