near the City of Greenville being lot number twenty of the subdivision known as Meadow Hill, plat of which is recorded in the office of Register of Deeds for Greenville County, bearing the following streets and boundaries:

Begins at an iron pin on O'Neill Street and continuing S. 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 200 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 82 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 50 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 200 feet to an iron pin on O'Neill Street; thence S. 82 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 60 feet to the beginning point.
