

WARRANT TO REAL ESTATE

in the City of Greenville, fronting on Vardry Street, beginning at a stake on Vardry Street and running thence N. 74 W. 110' to a stake on corner of Vardry and Anderson Streets; thence S. 30 1/2 W. along said Anderson Street 127' 7"; thence S. 68 1/2 E. 110' 4"; thence N. 26 1/2 E. 168 feet to initial corner; being all that remains of the lot conveyed to R. L. McGee by E. S. Hill, deed dated January 25, 1906, reference to which is cited.
