all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

in the City of Greenville, on Wilton Street, and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a stake on the East side of Wilton Street 160 feet from the Northeast corner of Wilton Street and Stone Avenue, and running thence S. 84 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 131 feet along line of lot formerly owned by C. C. Good; thence N. 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 50 feet to line of lot formerly owned by Mountain City Land & Improvement Company; thence N. 84 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 131 feet to a stake on Wilton Street; thence with Wilton Street S. 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 50 feet to the beginning.
