Beginning at a rock corner at a distance North of the Gap Creek Road, thence N. 47° 26' E. about 34 chains to a chestnut tree, thence S. 76° 21' W. 30.50 chains to a dogwood, 1031; thence S. 6° W. 16.50 chains to a rock 80' thence S. 22° E. 23.0 to a P.O. 10'; thence N. 36° E. 26 chains to the beginning corner, containing One Hundred Acres.
