All that certain piece, parcel and tract of land, lying and being in Greenville

County and State aforesaid on Enoree River, adjoining lands of Phillip Bishop, Benjamin

Bowling and others; Beginning at a stake or bridge on Enoree River and running thence
with the road South to a stone 3x; thence S. 69 1/3 W. 18.13 to a stone 3x; and post oak;
thence South 21 E. 23.25 (should be 11 according to plat) to a pine 3x; thence N. 68 E.
28.30 to a stone 3x; thence N. 48 E. 10.60 to a stake on the bank of Enoree River; thence
up the ditch or river to the bridge on the ditch, the beginning corner, supposed to contain
45 acres, more or less. Upon a re-survey and plat of this tract it has been found that
