all that gives, giveth or hath of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

and described as follows; to-wit: on the North side of West Earle St. in the First Ward of the City of Greenville, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:
 Beginning at an iron pin on the North side of said Street approximately 110 feet East of Townes St., at corner of lot formerly owned by Oeland, and running thence with line of said Oeland lot N. 1-41 E. 200 feet, more or less, to iron pin; thence S. 83-15 E. 70 feet, more or less, to corner of lot conveyed by C. P. Haynsworth to Ola G. Cuerry; thence with line of last mentioned lot S. 1-41 W. 200 feet, more or less to an iron pin on Earle St.; thence with Earle St. N. 83-15 W. 70 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner. Williams, his heirs and assigns, against all and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim, the same, or any part thereof.
