We show on the plat to the Hattie Manufacturing Company property and described by metes and bounds as follows: Beginning in the center of the Rock Shoals Road, on the 72d line of Hattie Manufacturing Company property and containing 8.625 E. 4.6 chs. to a stake on the river; thence with the said river S. E. 1.01 chs. to a stake; thence N. E. 2.81 chs. to the center of Rock Shoals Road; thence with said road N. E. 1.1 chs. to the beginning corner and containing 4.6 acres, more or less.
