In the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. H. Glenn, his heirs and assigns,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, bounded and described as follows: Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing twenty-three and three-fourths (23 $\frac{3}{4}$ ) acres, more or less, and having the following waters and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stake in the road and running thence N. 30 W. 4.50 to a stake in the road; thence N. 12 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 7.50 to a stake in the road; thence N. 70 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 12.40 to a stake in the Greenville Road; thence S. 21 W. 18.94 with the last named road to a stake; thence R. 34 S. 23.00 to the beginning corner, bounded by lands of J. H. Glenn, Mrs. Jane Barnett, and others.

This land lies on the east side of Buncombe Road, about 12 miles north of Greenville County House.
