Beckwithall that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs, Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and being Lots Nos. 7 and 8 fronting on a road extending from the G. S. & A. Railroad to Piney Road, known as Piney Mountain Park, Lot No. 7 fronting on road running from the Piney Road, known as Piney Mountain Park, Lot No. 7 fronting on road running from the G. S. & A. Railroad to Piney Road 116 feet, and extending back along the right of way of the G. S. & A. Railroad 740 feet to corner; thence extending along the line of Lot No. 8 to the road, 687 feet. Lot No. 8 beginning at a stake 116 feet above the G. S. & A. Railroad line on road leading from Piney Road to the G. S. & A. Railroad and extending along the line of Lot No. 7, 687 feet to corner; thence along the line of Lot No. 9, 672 feet to the above mentioned road; thence extending along said road 116 feet to corner of Lot No. 7, Plat of said park being recorded in Plat Book E, page 201, P.
