being two lots, known as Nos. 9 and 10, in a subdivision known as East Over, having the following metes and bounds, according to a plat recorded in Plat Book G, page 68:

Lot No. 9; Beginning at an iron pin 64.3 feet from the corner of Ackley and Maco Streets and running thence S. 63-45 W., 143.42 feet to a stake, joint corners of lots Nos. 10 and 9; thence N. 30 W., 56 feet to a stake, joint corners of lots Nos. 9 and 8; thence N. 63-45 E., 137.37 feet to an iron pin on Maco Street, and thence with Maco Street 56 feet to the beginning corner.
