all that place, place or lot of land in Chick Springs.

containing 24 $\frac{1}{2}$  acres, more or less and having the following noted and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stake in middle of road leading to Paris, and running thence S. 3 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 6.30 to angle in road; thence S. 22 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 2.15 to angle in road; thence S. 54 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 2.12 to angle in road; thence S. 18 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 5.45 to angle in road; thence S. 85 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 4.00 to stake in middle of road; thence N. 80 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 3.50 to stone; thence S. 68 1/8 E. 5.00 to stone; thence N. 28 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 1.15 to iron pin; thence N. 29 W. 36.75 to stake in middle of road leading to Greenville, corner of Sarah R.
