In the State aforesaid the said J. C. Ragsdale is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said R. P. Harris all of my right, title and interest of, in and to all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Dunklin Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying on waters of Reedy River, adjoining lands of Mrs. McDavid, J. W. Sullivan and others, containing sixteen acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a stone 3xnm on J. W. Sullivan's line; thence S. 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 16.35 to a stone 3xnm; thence down the marshes of the branch about 9.50 to a stake 3xom; thence N. 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 10.55 to a P. O. 3xm; thence N. 48 W. 13.60 to the beginning corner, being the same tract of land conveyed to Hudgens & Ragsdale by J. W. Gray, Master, by deed dated January 4, 1911, recorded in R. W. C.
